- Continue on through the rolling heartland of the Wakatipu Basin up to the Coronet Peak view-point. Spectacular photo opportunity with birds-eye views over the basin, the Remarkables mountain range and Arrowtown.
- There is a selection of renowned New Zealand artists exhibiting their works in galleries dotted around the Basin. Option to visit Peter Beadle, Graham Brinsley, Thomas Brown, amongst others.
- No tour is complete without visiting the historic gold mining settlement of Arrowtown. It's beautiful tree lined streets and colonial style buildings add to the old world charm of this picturesque village. Plenty of boutique shops, restaurants and cafes to choose from.
- Next stop is the AJ Hackett Bungy Centre at the Kawarau bridge, home of bungy jumping and the epicentre of New Zealand's adrenalin sports reputation. Watch the intrepid jumpers from the viewing gantry or why not take the plunge yourself!
- We would recommend Amisfield Winery for lunch with its spectacular views over Lake Hayes and outlook towards Coronet Peak ski field.
- The perfect way to round off the day is to spend a couple of hours wandering around the shops and cafes of down town Queenstown.

- The Gibbston Valley is the start of New Zealand's southern-most wine region and home to some very well known wineries such as Gibbston Valley, Peregrine, Chard Farm amongst others. Selected visits will be arranged.
- The Bannockburn/Cromwell area at the end of the Kawarau Gorge is the true heart of the Central Otago wine region and produces some of New Zealand's finest Pinot Noirs. Option to visit Amisfiled, Felton Road, Akarua, and Mt Difficulty wineries.
- We suggest Mt Difficulty winery for lunch with its spectacular views over the Cromwell basin.
- Return to Queenstown via the Kawarau Gorge and time permitting, a wander around the town centre and waterfront.
